Jacques-Rémy Girerd is a producer and director of animated films. He studied at the École des Beaux-Arts in Lyon, France, and started making cinema movies in 1978 with short films based on plasticine animation. In 1981, he set up the Folimage studio in Valence, specialising in the creation of animated films. In 1998, his film "Charlie's christmas" won the Car-

toon d'Or from the European Association of Animation Film. In 2003, he produced the film "Raining cats and frogs". His film "Mia and the Migoo" won the European Film Award in 2009. By the end of this year, he will release his production "A cat in Paris" (by Alain Gagnol and Jean-Loup Felicioli). At the same time, he is working on another feature film project called "Aunt Hilda!".

For the past ten years, Fabian Erlinghäuser has been working at Cartoon Saloon, the Oscar nominated Animation studio from Ireland. He was animation supervisor of the Oscar Academy Award nominated feature film "The Secret Of Kells", which premiered at the Berlinale and went on to win audience awards in Annecy and Edinburgh. Cartoon Saloon's work includes the TV-show "Skunk Fu" as well as award-winning short-films such as "From Darkness", which also made the Oscar shortlist a few years ago. Fabian's work ranges from feature films to short films and commercials. He also occasionally teaches at the "Animation Workshop" in Denmark.
